Junior Achievement

We enjoyed another visit from **Mr. Chasmar** Wells from M&T Bank as part of the Junior Achievement outreach program. This week Mr. Wells helped us practice being part of a production line. We worked in teams to create paper donuts for the Sweet-O Donut **Shop**. Our teams discovered the importance of working together, and learned how the **efforts of one person** can positively or negatively affect a team **outcome**. Two of our three teams were not able to produce any **defect-free donuts**. The most successful team only created **two** out of twenty donuts that were of high enough quality to sell in the donut shop ... an amazing lesson in quality control, workmanship and wise use of resources.
